



## Call for Travel Scholarship

The Causal and Adaptive Learning for Policy (CALP) research group, hosted within the School of Economics at the University of Cape Town (UCT), invites applications for up to ten travel scholarships to attend the 20th EfD Annual Meeting at IIM Kozhikode, Kerala, India, 12–14 November 2026.

The scholarship covers the cost of return economy airfare, with priority given to participants from EfD-affiliated countries in Sub-Saharan Africa: **Ethiopia, Kenya, Uganda, Tanzania, Ghana, Rwanda, and Nigeria**. Within this group, early-career and women researchers are given first consideration. Applicants from other EfD member countries will be considered should vacancies remain after the primary selection round. Accommodation, airport transfers, and other local costs will be covered by the local organisers, EfD India.
